

Mobile Bilge Water Collection vessel operates in Austria and Hungary for the first time!

How does it work?

1. Book the service



Please contact the Bilgenentölungsgesellschaft by phone and set time and place for the waste disposal service.

Important: If you are not able to keep the appointment, make sure to inform the Bilgenentöler as soon as possible!

2. Which wastes can be delivered?

You can dispose of bilge water, used oils and other oily and greasy ship wastes (oily rags, filters, bins, ...) free of charge!

Important: The Bilgenentöler does not take over any other wastes!

3. Conditions for free disposal

Before you hand over your wastes you will receive the "acceptance conditions". With your signature you are confirming that no solvents, paints, etc. have been put into the bilge!

Important: The use of the bilge for collection of other wastes is forbidden!

4. Confirmation of proper waste disposal

After the disposal you will receive a confirmation into the oil control book. If there is no oil control book onboard, you receive a certificate which approves, that you have disposed your wastes according to the rules.

Important: Keep a valid oil control book on board!

Besides oily and greasy ship wastes, you can also dispose trash, residuals, recyclables as well as other hazardous ship wastes (batteries, paints, solvents, etc.) there. The services will be free of charge for 2 X 20 working days in May/June and in August 2011.

Important: **Separate your wastes onboard!** This will save you time for the disposal and contribute to saving valuable resources and energy!

Other hazardous ship wastes		paints, solvents, batteries, electronic devices
Residuals		textiles, light bulbs, broken dishes
